








Cucumber Soup – Story Problems grade K

Mixed addition facts to 10 and the corresponding subtraction facts.

<p>3 bugs pushed the cucumber.</p> <p>Some bugs pulled the cucumber.</p> <p>Altogether 5 bugs pushed and pulled the cucumber.</p> <p>How many bugs pulled?</p> 	<p>After pushing the cucumber, some spiders called for help.</p> <p>5 more spiders helped.</p> <p>Altogether 8 spiders pushed.</p> <p>How many spiders pushed at the start?</p> 
<p>4 butterflies pushed the cucumber.</p> <p>5 more butterflies helped pull.</p> <p>How many butterflies helped altogether?</p> 	<p>6 bees were helping.</p> <p>2 bees left.</p> <p>How many bees stayed to help?</p> 
<p>10 lady bugs are helping.</p> <p>4 lady bugs are pushing. The others are pulling.</p> <p>How many lady bugs are pulling?</p> 	<p>You counted all the bugs.</p> <p>2 bugs left. Now there were 8 bugs.</p> <p>How many bugs did you count at first?</p> 
<p>The ants made soup</p> <p>First they cooked 3 cucumbers, and then they cooked 2 more.</p> <p>How many cucumbers did they cook altogether?</p> 	<p>There were 7 bugs at the party.</p> <p>1 bugs left.</p> <p>How many bugs were still at the party?</p>
