

Peek-a-Boo Pennies

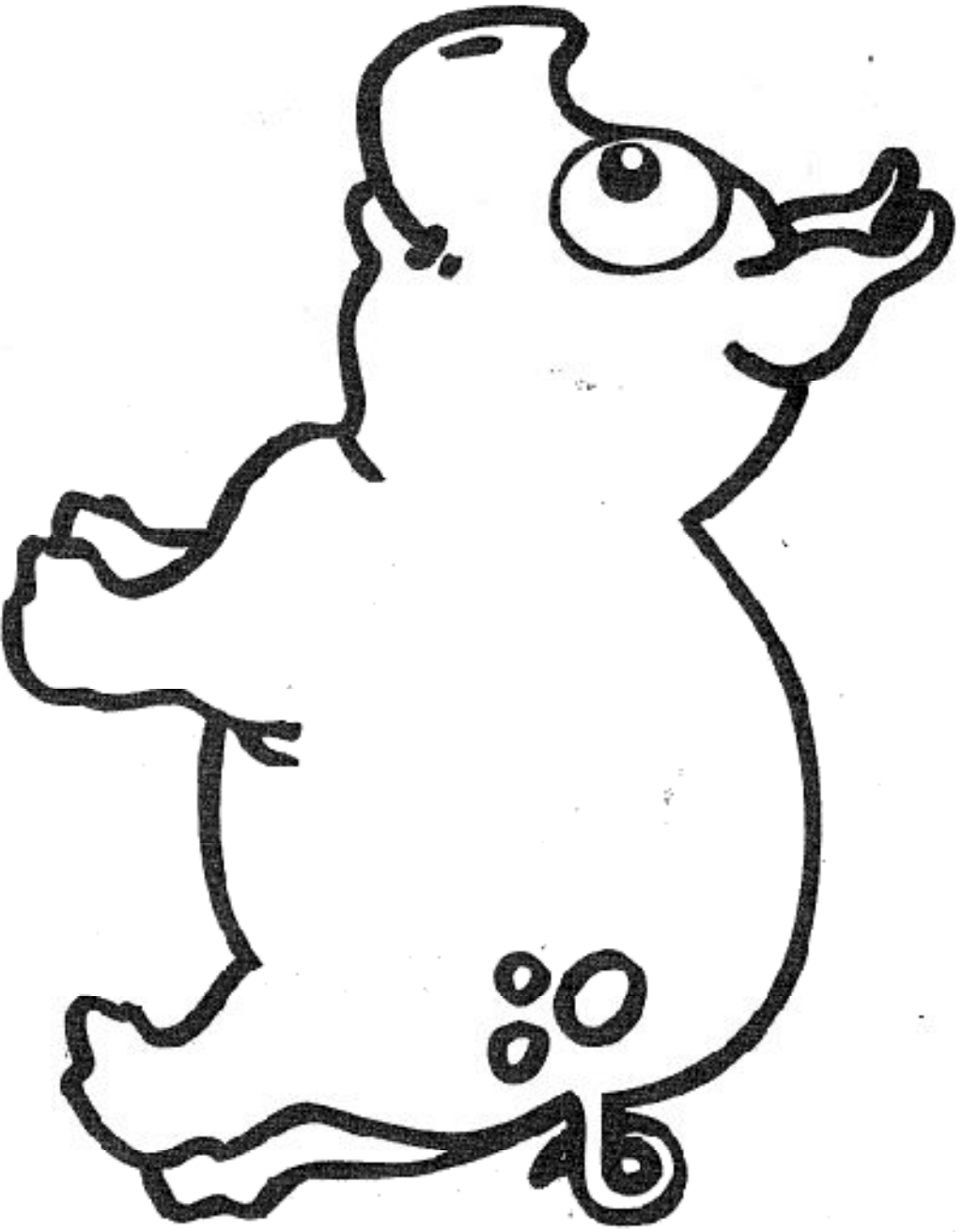
Pair up students and provide each pair with a piggy bank, 12 pennies, a paper cup, number cards ⁶⁻¹² and a Peek-a-Boo recording sheet

- 1 student draws a number card. This is the number of pennies that will be in the piggy bank for 1-5 turns
- Partner 1 gets the amount of pennies equal to the number on the card and puts them in the piggy bank.
- Partner 2 closes their eyes while Partner 1 takes the paper cup and covers any amount of the pennies.
- When partner 1 has covered the desired amount of pennies they say "Peek-a-Boo"
- Partner 2 counts the number of pennies showing and records that number on the Peek-a-Boo activity sheet.
- Then Partner 2 determines how many pennies are hiding under the cup and writes that number, and completes the equation on the activity sheet.
- Partner 1 checks the answer
- Switch places and the game continues

Extension: Use nickels and dimes to reinforce counting by 5's and 10's
