<p>Words</p> <p>The centipede had 152 shoes. After he put his shoes in boxes, he has 48 left over.</p> <p>How many boxes does he have?</p>	<p>Pictures</p>	<p>Equation</p>
<p>Words</p> <p>The centipede took off 28 shoes before he took a break. He then took off some more shoes. He took off 50 shoes altogether.</p> <p>How many shoes did he take off after his break?</p>	<p>Pictures</p>	<p>Equation</p>
<p>Words</p> <p>The centipede had 475 shoes. He left some at school. He had 156 at home.</p> <p>How many shoes did he leave at school?</p>	<p>Pictures</p>	<p>Equation</p>
