


Sold – Story Problems Grade 3

Start unknown. Addition facts to 1000 and the corresponding subtraction facts.



<p>I bought some pens.</p> <p>I gave 223 pens to my Dad. Now I have 44 pens left.</p> <p>How many pens did I buy?</p> 	<p>I spent some money on an old time barber pole. Then I spent \$128 more on a statue. Altogether I spent \$459.</p> <p>How much did I spend on the old time barber pole?</p> 
<p>The auctioneer said sold to me over and over again.</p>  <p>He said 'Sold!' to another man 322 times.</p> <p>Altogether he said 'Sold!' 401 times.</p> <p>How many times did he say 'Sold!' to me?</p>	<p>I held an auction and sold some things.</p>  <p>I sold 36 things to my little brother and some to my friends.</p> <p>Altogether I sold 162 things.</p> <p>How many times did I sell to my friends?</p>
<p>I brought some coins in my pocket.</p> <p>I spent 67 cents on a bottle collection. Then I had 99 cents left.</p> <p>How many cents did I have in my pocket to start with?</p> 	<p>I bought a collection of old brown bottles.</p> <p>Then I bought 425 green bottles. Altogether I bought 639 bottles.</p> <p>How many brown bottles did I buy?</p> 
<p>My Dad and I loaded my auction items into the front and back of the truck.</p>  <p>We put 108 items in the front. Altogether we put 320 items in the truck.</p> <p>How many items did we put into the back of the truck?</p>	<p>We dropped off some auction items at my Grandpa's house.</p>  <p>We had 33 items left.</p> <p>Altogether I bought 190 auction items.</p> <p>How many items did we leave at Grandpa's?</p>
