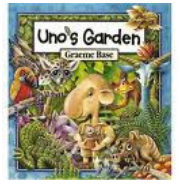


## Uno's Garden – Story Problems Grades 3

Change unknown. Addition facts to 1000 and the corresponding subtraction facts.



The forest had 383 types of trees.

After Uno climbed some of them, he had 127 types of trees left still to climb.



How many types of trees did he climb?

The 'others' built 219 houses in the first month and built some more in the second month. Altogether they built 781 houses.



How many houses did the 'others' build in the second month?

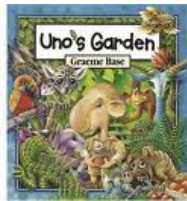
As the village grew, there were 449 children. Some went to school. 168 children were too young for school. How many went to school?



The hunters searched for the Snagglebites for 634 minutes before they stopped to rest. They then searched some more. They searched for 851 minutes altogether. How many minutes did they search after they rested?



The tourists took 383 pictures of the Timid Tumbletops. Some of the pictures were blurry. They had 97 good pictures.



How many blurry pictures were there?

The railway had 261 m of bridges and a large length without bridges.



Altogether there was 997 m of railway.

How long was the track without bridges?

567 animals were in the forest. Some were studied by the scientists. 278 animals were never studied.



How many animals were the scientists able to study?

The city was getting bigger. In the first year there were 168 buildings. After the second year there were 849 buildings altogether.



How many buildings were built in the second year?
