



Sold – Story Problems Grade 4

Start unknown. Addition facts to 10 000 and the corresponding subtraction facts, addition and subtraction decimal.

<p>I bought some pens.</p> <p>I gave 1223 pens to my Dad. Now I have 744 pens left.</p> <p>How many pens did I buy?</p> 	<p>I spent some money on an old time barber pole. Then I spent \$4128 more on a statue.</p> <p>Altogether I spent \$5459.</p> <p>How much did I spend on the old time barber pole?</p> 
<p>The auctioneer said sold to me over and over again.</p> <p>He said 'Sold!' to another man 2828 times.</p> <p>Altogether he said 'Sold!' 4501 times.</p> <p>How many times did he say 'Sold!' to me?</p> 	<p>I held an auction and sold some things to my friends</p> <p>I sold 736 things to my little brother.</p> <p>Altogether I sold 1562 things.</p> <p>How many times did I sell to my friends?</p> 
<p>I brought some coins in my pocket.</p> <p>I spent \$5.67 cents on a bottle collection.</p> <p>Then I had \$2.99 cents left.</p> <p>How many cents did I have in my pocket to start with?</p> 	<p>I bought a collection of old brown bottles.</p> <p>Then I spent \$14.25 more on green bottles.</p> <p>Altogether I spent \$21.39.</p> <p>How much did I spend on the brown bottles?</p> 
<p>My Dad and I loaded my auction items into the front and back of the truck.</p> <p>It took 0.25 hours to put the items in the front. Altogether it took 90 minutes to load the front and back of the truck.</p> <p>How long did it take to load the back of the truck?</p> 	<p>We left some auction items at my Grandpa's house.</p> <p>We had 3.3kg worth of items left.</p> <p>Altogether we had bought, 6.04kg worth of items auction items.</p> <p>How many kilograms of auction items did we leave at Grandpa's?</p>
