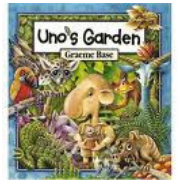


Uno's Garden – Story Problems Grades 4

Change unknown. Addition facts to 10 000 and the corresponding subtraction facts and addition sub to 100th



The forest had 5383 types of trees.

After Uno climbed some of them, he had 4627 types of trees left still to climb.



How many types of trees did he climb?

The 'others' built 219 houses in the first month and built some more in the second month. Altogether they built 3781 houses.



How many houses did the others build in the second month?

As the village grew, there were 6449 children.

Some went to school. 1168 children were too young for school. How many went to school?



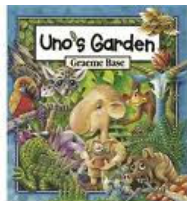
The hunters searched for the Snagglebites for 6.75 hours before they stopped to sleep.



They then searched some more. They searched for 11.5 hours altogether. How many hours did they search after they slept?

The tourists spent \$57.38 on printing pictures of the Timid Tumbletops.

Some of the pictures were blurry. They had \$18.97 worth of good pictures. How much did they spend on the blurry pictures?



The railway had 0.61 km of bridges and a large length without bridges.



Altogether there was 9.97 km of railway.

How long was the track without bridges?

5 567 animals were in the forest. Some were studied by the scientists. 3 278 animals were never studied. How many animals were the scientists able to study?



The city was getting bigger. In the first year there were 16.8 hectares of land taken up by buildings. After the second year there were 58.49 hectares of land taken.
